



RoHS Certificate of Compliance

Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS)

The products made by Hexagon's Agriculture division are complied with the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU, which restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment, entered into force on 21/7/2011, with its obligations becoming effective from 2/1/2013.

All material applied in our products are **RoHS compliant**, this means that the components used in the manufacturing process do not contain any of the restricted component's substances referred to in Annex II of the RoHS directive, in concentrations more than those permitted under the Directive, as follows:

Lead (Pb)	0,1% (<1000 ppm)
Mercury (Hg):	0,1% (<1000 ppm)
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB):	0,1% (<1000 ppm)
Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI):	0,1% (<1000 ppm)
Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE):	0,1% (<1000 ppm)
Cadmium (Cd):	0,01% (100 ppm)

Conformance is based on declarations received from our suppliers that the products and raw materials they supply comply with the above European Parliament & Council Directives. However, we do not routinely analyze their products for the above substances, nor do we require our raw materials suppliers to do so.
